

Gazprom reports average gas production cost at \$28.21/mcm

According to the segment information of the financial report of Gazprom for January-September 2016, the average production cost of natural gas in Q3-2016 was at ₱1823 per 1000 cubic meters (mcm) or \$28.21/mcm or \$0.88/MMBtu. In Q3-2015, Gazprom reported ₱1690/mcm or \$26.90/mcm or \$0.84/MMBtu, respectively.

The average US dollar rate in Q3-2016 was ₽64.62 compared with ₽62.85 in Q3-2015.

The average cost in in the period of January-September 2016 is reported at ₱1788/mcm or \$26.21/mcm or \$0.82/MMBtu compared with ₱1652/mcm or \$27.99/mcm or \$0.87/MMBtu in the same period of 2015. Russia's Central Bank reported the average US dollar rate in January-September 2016 at ₱68.22 and at ₱59.02 in January-September 2015.

The average price of gas sold out of the former Soviet Union in Q3-2016 is reported at \$162.5/mcm and to the former Soviet countries at \$147.2/mcm. The average price of gas sold outside of Russia can be calculated at \$161.0/mcm. Notably, Russia's Federal Customs Service (FCS) reported the average price of gas exported out of Russia in Q3-2016 at \$149.7/mcm (FCS reports only gas produced in Russia).


